General Information

School of Languages where fluency in Spanish is guaranteed. 75% of the staff is Hispanic/Latino and students take classes in both English and Spanish (blended). Students get more practice with the language as opposed to the traditional classroom setting. The school has been open since 2007 where we started off as **Chicos Felices** [Happy Children] in a much smaller building. We've been at this new location since 2017 due to how much the school had grown. It was originally only Chicos Felices but it was discovered that after leaving, the students would lose the Spanish gained, so classes were extended up to Grade 12 so they could continue with their languages.

We prepare our students to compete in a global market and we are una escuela de Dios [a school of God] (but religion is not forced).

Both logos were carefully created with their meanings in mind.

The **San Pedro** [Saint Peter] logo features two keys to represent authority, a globe to represent the internationality of the school, a Bible to represent the word we stand on, and two olive branches to represent peace, growth, and not forgetting our beginnings.

The **Chicos Felices** Logo represents the name of the institution, "Happy Children". It features a globe to, once again, show internationality and children around the world.

Block A - Chicos Felices

\$375 monthly / \$1,066 per term

- Polo shirt - \$30
- Skort - \$17
- Uniform set (shirt + skort) - \$45

Boy's khaki pants can be bought at local stores. Elastic pants recommended assisting with potty training. Students wear yellow socks with black or brown shoes.

- Students entering **K1** must be 1 year old.
- Students entering **K2** must be 2 by October 31st. Potty training starts here.
- Students entering **K3** must be 3 by October 31st.
- Students entering **K4** must be 4 by October 31st.
- Students entering **K5** must be 5 by October 31st.
 - K5 is actually a part of San Pedro and wears the San Pedro International School Primary uniform. The students begin Mandarin classes.

Kindergarten uses the **Abeka curriculum**. It is integrated with Spanish. They'd learn both Spanish and English for each concept. For example, when learning to recognize the color red, they'd learn 'rojo' and 'red' at the same time.

All classroom instructions are in Spanish.

Small class sizes.

Items needed:

Snacks, breakfast, and lunch can be bought at the school cafe in the morning for students.

Block B - High School

\$510 monthly / \$1,450 per term

Skirts must be made. The school sells the fabric at **\$15 a yard**. To be pleated on the checkered side.
The white shirt/khaki pants can be bought from stores.

White, brown or burgundy socks can be worn with black or brown shoes.

Ministry of Education curriculum for examinations (BJC & BGCSE).

Exam subjects are taught in the morning and Spanish class is taught in the afternoons.

The Spanish classes are separated by levels (Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced) to accommodate all learners. Students can advance at their own pace.

The English class uses **Abeka**. Other books are to be bought at the store.

Abeka curriculum is used for English.

Santillana for Spanish (leading curriculum in Spain).

Subjects are taught bilingually, some in English, others in Spanish.

Mandarin starts at K5.

No more than **16 students** per class.

Students take GLAT.
